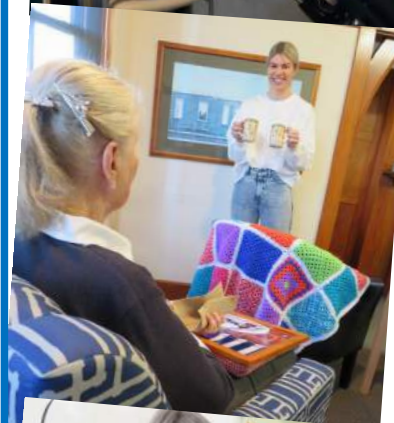




What a difference a base makes!
